Well Pet Requirements: All vaccines must have been administered by a licensed veterinarian. Client must present written proof of current vaccinations for each pet prior to attending doggy-day play (ddp) or becoming a slumber party guest. If external parasites are found during services, pets will be treated at the cost to the client. Although sick or unvaccinated pets are not permitted to attend BCP, the client acknowledges that they are placing the pet into an area in which communicable diseases may pass between seemingly healthy pets. If following a provided service date the pet shows signs of illness, the client may not hold BCP liable for any inadvertent exposure the pet may have contracted, and that if the client requests an exam, treatment, or medications for the pet that it will be provided by BCP at full cost to the client. Adult Dogs Puppies Must be current on Rabies, Distemper/Parvo and Bordetella (Bordetella every 6 months) Must be 12 weeks or older & have received (2) Distemper/Parvo vaccines and (2) Bordetella vaccines

Doggy DayPlay (DDP) Safety Policy: While all dogs must pass the preliminary temperament test to be eligible for the DDP program, some behaviors may be revealed only after a dog has attended daycare for a number of days. If conduct deemed unacceptable or dangerous occurs and after our staff has taken measures to correct and re-teach the behaviors in question, BCP reserves the right to immediately deny any dog's eligibility at any time in the event that a dog shows the potential to cause severe injury or to be unwilling to adjust to the DDP program. The client agrees to the terms of DDP and releases BCP and staff as well as the owners of other dogs attending DDP of all liability. DDP is not a training ground for dogs with difficult issues nor is it the responsibility of BCP attendants to devote extensive attention to a single dog's problem issues. While in DDP, dogs may not wear chain or pronged collars in which other dogs' teeth might be caught; flat or rolled collars are best. Electronic collars are NOT acceptable, but the Optional Services Handling Form must be signed in addition to this form. Some dogs are known to play by nipping. If this is the case and your pet shows these signs, an option of Humane Society approved muzzle ([click here to read more on muzzling](#)) can be provided at no additional charge and your dog may continue to participate in DDP. Dogs must not have any conditions which can be aggravated by active play or have any contagious disease symptoms such as cough, cold, nasal discharge, etc. Although the DDP environment is a safe and well supervised area, the client acknowledges that rough play can be an inherent part of dog behavior in DDP. Despite well trained staff and constant supervision, play may become too rough and an injury to pets may result. Should the pets require immediate treatment before the client can be contacted, the client authorizes BCP to treat pets as deemed necessary by a vet professional closest to BCP. Following any injury, BCP will attempt to contact the client as soon as possible, but regardless the client acknowledges and assumes all financial responsibility for treatment provided by signing this document. Regarding behavior, if the staff determines that any dog shows excessive stress or aggressive behavior in daycare, the client gives permission for BCP to transfer the dog to an individual inside enclosure within our facility. We will make every effort made to inform the client of the situation. BCP reserves the right to immediately deny any dog's eligibility at any time in the event that a dog causes severe injury or displays dangerous aggression. PHOTO & VIDEO RELEASE: I agree to allow BCP. to use my pet's name and any images or videos taken while he/she is in the care of BCP., in any form or format, for use, at any time, in any media, marketing, advertising, illustration, trade or promotional materials. EVENT OF CATOSTROPHIC HAPPENINGS: BCP shall not be responsible for pet replacement over the cost of \$1,000/family. RIGHT OF REFUSAL: Beau's Chateau for Pets reserves the right to refuse admittance to any pet or dismiss any pet that does not meet our daycare/boarding standards. The determination shall be made at the sole discretion of employees of Beau's Chateau for Pets.

*DDP Hours will be 7am-6pm Monday-Friday, Saturday 9am-3pm and closed Sunday. Should a pet be dropped off or picked up before 7am or after 6pm during the week and before 9am and after 3pm on Saturdays will have a Convenience Fee of \$15.00 for the early/late arrival/departure and which shall be assessed to the account.

*Slumber Party guests WITHOUT DDP add-on hours will be 8am-5pm Monday-Friday, Saturday 9am-3pm and Sunday for both slumber party guests with or without DDP add-on pets must be picked up at either 11am OR 8pm.

Sundays and Holidays are charged a FULL DAY RATE regardless of pick-up time. By signing below, I understand and agree to the terms stated above, and I release Beau's Chateau for Pets as well as the owners of other dogs attending DDP from any and all liability.
